



Mandate for research group leaders at the faculty of engineering and science

Research group leaders shall lead their research groups so that they provide a good environment for activities related to research and development, in collaboration with the department lead and faculty. A fundament for robust research groups entails a healthy economic foundation for financing research activities, postdocs and ph.d.-students. This is done by:

- 1) Leading the development and implementation of a long-term research strategy for the group, herein lead the groups' work with:
 - a) Developing and confining the groups' project portefolio
 - b) Seek external funding to the research group
 - c) Develop the groups' publication and dissemination activities
 - d) Build networks internally at HVL, regionally, nationally and internationally
 - e) Conduct idea capture for commercialization of research
- 2) Lead/coordinate the groups' work to:
 - a) Involve students and newly employed in research group activities
 - b) Provide a good environment for students' research development
 - c) Ensure a tight link between education and research, and the field of practice (where relevant)
- 3) Ensure that research ethic issues (sensitive data/publication) are on the research group agenda and discussed, and (when needed) reported to the department lead
- 4) Strive towards good representation of all genders within the group
- 5) Prioritize small assets allocated to joint research group activities
